WOMEN'S RIGHTS MANIFESTO - WHAT YOU CAN DO

ELECTION DATE : 6 MAY 2021

YOUR CANDIDATES

- Contact the election candidates in your constituency and region. Use the Manifesto to help you talk to them about your concerns.
- Pick one or two sections from the Manifesto that resonates the most with you. Base your questions specifically around these issues. Ask candidates if they will uphold women's rights on the points you raised if you were to vote for them.
- You can also ask candidates to support Women's Pledges in their own political party, for example, SNP Women's Pledge, Labour Women's Declaration etc.

ELECTION EVENTS

- Attend online hustings and other election related events, such as the BBC's Scottish Parliament election debates.
- Mention the Manifesto and ask specific questions from one or two sections.

MEDIA

- Post about the Manifesto on social media.
- Use the hashtag [#WomensManifestoScotland](https://twitter.com/WomensManifestoScotland)
- Write articles for local newspapers or send in a reader's comment.

PROMOTION

- Speak to family, friends and other women in your social circle who might not be aware of how women's rights are currently being eroded.
- Print out the A4 Poster and stick it somewhere in your area. Or print several copies and post them through people's letterboxes.
- Write messages related to the Manifesto on slates and wooden boards. Leave in locations where people can come across them.
